

PORTFOLIO COMMENTARY

The Global Balanced Portfolio returned +1.03% in January, taking 2026 returns to +1.03%.

Heightened geopolitical tensions set the tone for the opening weeks of 2026. Safe haven demand escalated pushing Gold to a new record high, at over \$5,500 per ounce. The nomination of Kevin Warsh, the new Fed Chair, at the end of January reassured markets somewhat leading to a sharp sell-off of some of the recent gains in precious metals.

US data continued to indicate a softening labour market, with weaker JOLTS figures and unemployment at 4.4%. The Federal Reserve held rates in the January meeting, as inflation remained sticky. In Europe, the Eurozone economy grew by 0.3% in Q4 2025, ahead of market expectations, as inflation moderated by 0.2% from November to December. The UK economy grew by 0.3% month-on-month in November, after recovering from a weaker October.

Global equities advanced through January, with the S&P 500 index briefly crossing the 7,000 threshold for the first time. Small caps continued to outperform large caps, as weakness in the software sector weighed on the concentrated, tech-heavy large-cap indexes. Emerging markets also gained, led by South Korea's reform-driven multi-month rally. The US dollar weakened further, reaching a four-year low on concerns over fiscal sustainability and diversification flows.






