FUND COMMENTARY

Market volatility spiked sharply in early February after ultra-low levels since late 2016. This was triggered by good news in the form of strong new US employment numbers and wage increases in January, which in turn triggered sudden fears for high inflation and high interest rates. After an initial rise in the ten-year Treasury yield to 2.95%, it has since drifted lower and the ten-year breakeven rate (reflecting inflation expectations) has barely moved. It therefore does not yet seem that material inflation (and interest rate) fears reflect in the bond market.


The US 4th quarter 2017 reporting season is almost complete. Results on both the top-line and earnings levels are accelerating, with growth currently at +7.6% and +14.4% respectively. This is +1.2% and +3.8% respectively better than consensus expectations. It is especially pleasing to see the strong top-line growth – the strongest since early 2012 which was still recovering from the low base of the credit crisis. Expectations for the coming year are for sales to continue their current solid growth track of +7%, and for earnings to further excel to +20%. Should such solid results materialise, we expect it to be constructive towards equity investing, other considerations pari-pasu.

The equity market has been climbing a proverbial wall of worry for some time, mainly because of general fears of high absolute valuations. Against this, the forward earnings multiple (P/E ratio) has through February dropped from being at a standard deviation above its long-term average to being very close to its long-term average (17.2 times vs 16.9 times). This has resulted from the drop in share prices combined with the ramp-up in earnings expectations. The high valuation argument therefore seems to no longer have such a strong case, while the inflation ghost may come and go on the road to normality since the deflation fears just seven months ago.
